

Nui shibori: Japanese stitched resist dyeing techniques

Beginner Level: Adult 16-up. Stitched shibori techniques are Japan's most unique contribution to the shaped resist dyeing tradition. Used for kimono as well as tablecloths and handkerchiefs this hand stitching was done by fine craftsmen and farmwives. Over the three sessions students will learn the three basic techniques and several variations and patterns. Class sessions will focus on demonstrating the techniques and looking at examples with some time for practice. These techniques are labor intensive and time consuming. Most of the stitching will be done outside of class-to be dved the following session. Students will complete samplers, a scarf and a bandanna or handkerchief. Supply fee of \$20 to be paid to the instructor at first class session. See the Arts Center of Saint Peter's website for supply list. Min. 4, max. 10. Registration Deadline: Tuesday, June 5.

The student can expect to study figural form from a live nude and/or clothed model interpreting it on canvas realistically or abstractly based upon the students' style. Basic oil painting knowledge is helpful but not necessary. This is also an excellent course for those who have prior experience with Kevin Kroeber to continue where you left off. 
Introduction to Stained Glass


